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**TDC MOTOR CLUB MONTHLY MINUTES FOR  
JULY 7, 2016**

**CHESTER COUNTY FOOD BANK - Downingtown, PA**

The July monthly meeting was called to order by the President, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Happy Birthday and/or Anniversary wishes were conveyed to all members celebrating during the month of July.

Ann Shuniak welcomed everyone to the Food Bank. Ann explained the facts about their operation. They distribute 2.65 million pounds of food - 850,000 lbs. of that being fresh produce and 590,000 lbs. of donated non-perishables. 1.13 million pounds of food was purchased and 739,000 lbs. of fresh food. There are 104 Partner Agencies that serve food cupboards and pantry shelters and meal sites for senior centers, youth and after school programs. Their operating budget - 89% supporting the hungry - 7% administrative - 4% fundraising. The food bank also has a "Mobile Market" that travels in neighborhoods. They accept all government food cards. After our meeting Ann took everyone on a tour of the facility.

The May minutes were emailed to all members. Minutes were accepted, seconded and approved. Starting with the June General Meeting the Minutes will be read aloud.

We received a Thank You card from Ty Pedicone, who won our Scholarship and a letter of thanks from a unit we had sent boxes of collected items from our "Cruise for the Troops". So far, our Cruises have been very successful. The Longhorn Steak House said they were inundated with customers since we have had our Cruises at Main Street.

**On the discussion of Drive Out Hunger:**

\*Pre-Show meeting will be at 10am at the Downingtown East High School. If you collected any door prizes, please bring them with you.

\*A poster was placed at Giant.  They are making up bags of food that can be purchased for \$5.

\*An email was sent to all members for volunteering. The email, "Sign-Up-Genius", allows you to choose your time and how you can help.

\*If you opt to do parking you are asked not to leave your post until you get a substitute. We are trying to have all parking volunteers equipped with walkie-talkies.

\*There will be boxes at the entrance for the collection of foods. It was told that people had brought food last year, but did not want to come into the show.

\*Dave Hatt will have two (2) Gators at DOH.

\*There will be only 20/21 trophies this year. 🇺🇸 Bulldog is swamped with his own business and has agreed to that amount.

\*All members are asked to wear their club shirt or hat or a royal blue shirt.

\*The Armadillo from Texas Roadhouse, the Cow from Chick-Fil-A and Rita's Water Ice will be attending DOH. Carolyn is still waiting to hear from Batman.

Frank Dubeck will have an answer soon in reference to coordinating the Halloween Show.

An email was sent to all members for those who are interested in purchasing sportswear. The deadline is July 15th.

Leon brought up the subject that all the same people were working the Cruises 🇺🇸 every month. Including setting up the signs, cones, parking, etc. And the same with cleaning up. It was suggested that we begin a sign-up sheet for volunteers. Other members are at the show, but we need them to volunteer also.
